Who is the entity's Data Protection Delegate (DPD) and how can it help you?

The DPD is a legally established figure whose main functions are to inform and advise the entity on the obligations that affect it, in terms of personal data protection, and to supervise its compliance. In addition, the DPD acts as a point of contact with the entity for any matter relating to the processing of personal data.

For what purpose do we process your personal data?

We process the personal data you provide us with your prior consent to send you informative and commercial communications about any degree offered by ISDE, to provide you with information about products and services, to facilitate the contracting of services offered by ISDE, as well as to inform you about the events developed by ISDE.

For how long will we process your data?

In the event that you consent to the use of your data for commercial and informative purposes, they will be kept indefinitely, until, where appropriate, you express your wish to delete them.

What is the legitimacy for the processing of your data?

The processing of your data is based on your consent, by ticking the box on the contact form. Specifically, the categories of personal data whose processing is based on your consent are the following: identification data, and contact data, including your social networks address. If you provide your profile data in social networks, you authorize ISDE to add you to the corporate and personal profiles of the entity's professionals. We will use your data to keep you informed of the activities and promotions developed by ISDE as well as those carried out by its professionals through these channels. These data will be processed on the legal basis of your consent and will be retained for as long as you remain a friend or follower of ours or our professionals. You may revoke your consent at any time, although this will not affect the lawfulness of the processing previously carried out. The provision of data for this purpose is voluntary. If data is nor provided, you will not be able to be a friend or follower of our social networks. The categories of data processed for this purpose are identification data.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time, and you may communicate it to us by any means. The withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the data processed prior to such revocation.

To which recipients will your data be communicated?

ISDE will not transfer your data to third parties without your express consent.

What are your rights when you provide us with your data?

Any person has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not we are processing their personal data. The persons concerned have the right to access their personal data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, to request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. Under the conditions provided for in the General Data Protection Regulation, interested parties may request the limitation of the processing of their data or their portability, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defense of claims.

Under certain circumstances and for reasons related to their particular situation, interested parties may oppose to the processing of their data. If you have given consent for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to its withdrawal. In these cases, we will stop processing the data or, where appropriate, we will stop processing it for that specific purpose, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defense of possible claims. All the aforementioned rights can be exercised through the means established at the beginning of this clause.

If there has been a violation of your rights, especially when you have not obtained satisfaction in its exercise, you can file a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency (contact details accessible at www.agpd.es), or other competent supervisory authority. You can also obtain more information about your rights by contacting these bodies. If you provide data of third parties, you assume the responsibility to inform them in advance of all the provisions of Article 14 of the General Data Protection Regulation under the conditions set forth in that provision and to obtain their consent to the processing of their data as indicated in this document.
